

Thank you for making 2016-2017 an amazing year. We accomplished so much – all because of your incredible support.

It is truly gratifying to know that so many of you chose once again to support advancements in healthcare at the University of Alberta Hospital site through the University Hospital Foundation.

Thanks in part to your generous support, we generated a total revenue of \$27.4 million - during a year in which many Albertans faced challenges in our recovering economy, and charities struggled to meet their fundraising goals. Thanks to generous

community support, we met and exceeded our expectations.

Our Brain Centre Campaign – the cornerstone of our fundraising activities – has now topped \$43 million. Fuelled by donor generosity, we advanced stroke care at the University of Alberta Hospital by putting Canada's first Stroke Ambulance on the road (for the complete story, see Making History on p. 4), and adding a second neurointerventional suite (Tools of the Trade, p. 6) where highly skilled neuro radiologists perform hundreds of delicate procedures on patients with strokes, aneurysms and serious head and spine injuries.

MAKING HISTORY

THANKS TO \$3.3 MILLION IN DONOR SUPPORT TO THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL FOUNDATION'S BRAIN CENTRE CAMPAIGN, RURAL ALBERTANS NOW HAVE FASTER ACCESS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA HOSPITAL'S WORLD CLASS STROKE TEAM.

Community support, including the 2016 Festival of Trees, put Canada's first Stroke Ambulance on the road.

And just like that, people living in central and northern Alberta have a much better chance of not only surviving a stroke, but of living without life-changing disabilities such as paralysis, loss of speech and memory loss.

This is the first Stroke Ambulance in the world to serve patients beyond a major urban centre.

"The Stroke Ambulance greatly reduces the time between stroke onset and life-saving treatment," says Dr. Tom Jeerakathil, stroke neurologist at the University of Alberta Hospital, and a driving force behind the Stroke Ambulance project. "With strokes, every minute saved is critical."


A fully operational CT scanner is mounted in the Stroke Ambulance, which is also equipped with Lifebot, the most advanced telemedicine technology in the world. The Lifebot enables a stroke neurologist at the University of Alberta Hospital to video conference with the patient and stroke team in the ambulance. If it's confirmed that the patient is suffering an ischemic stroke, they will be given the clot busting drug tPA in the ambulance.

STROKE AMBULANCE IN ACTION

Scott McNair, 34, of Mayerthorpe (120 kilometres northwest of Edmonton) knew he was having a stroke the moment his arm went numb. An equipment operator in Redwater, Scott was familiar with stroke symptoms through first aid training, and experience. "My dad had a stroke when he was 59."

Scott's stroke happened at work. A quick-thinking co-worker called for an ambulance. When Scott arrived at the Redwater Health Centre, staff called the stroke team at the University of Alberta Hospital.

Within minutes, Canada's first Stroke Ambulance was on its way to deliver stroke care. Scott recovered, and recently returned to work.

TOOLS OF THE TRADE

Margaret Miller didn't feel a thing. One minute she was cleaning out her laundry room. The next she was on the floor. She couldn't move. She couldn't talk.

Margaret had suffered a massive stroke.

If not for a highly specialized clot retrieval procedure known as an endovascular thrombectomy, performed in one of two Neurovascular Interventional Suites (pictured above) at the University of Alberta Hospital – the only two in northern Alberta – Margaret may well be in a nursing home today, if she survived at all.

The University Hospital Foundation's Brain Centre Campaign fully funded the purchase of a second \$1.5 million suite in 2016. Now doctors like Jeremy Rempel, a neuro radiologist at the University of Alberta Hospital, have the ability to save the lives of patients who – like Margaret – are facing life-threatening brain conditions.

"With the imaging equipment we have in the interventional suites, we can do the most complex minimally invasive procedures" says Dr. Rempel. "Margaret had about a 30% chance of recovering from her stroke when she arrived.

"After we removed the clot blocking blood flow to her brain, she made a full recovery."

BIG STEP FORWARD

The University Hospital Foundation is beginning the critical final phase of the Brain Centre Campaign – a completely re-designed and expanded Neuro Intensive Care Unit (Neuro ICU) for patients with stroke, life-threatening head injuries and complex brain conditions.

Working closely with the Government of Alberta and Alberta Health Services, the Brain Centre Campaign is committed to supporting the building of the most advanced Neuro ICU in North America.

"I've asked the Minister of Infrastructure to proceed with the development of a business case for the expansion [of the Neuro ICU], a necessary step to determine timelines and project costs" says Sarah Hoffman, Deputy Premier and Minister of Health.

With the most advanced technology, every breath a patient takes will be monitored by dedicated, experienced staff. Using state-of-the-art rehabilitation equipment, patients can begin rehab the moment they're able, even before they are able to leave their bed.

"We've come this far thanks to incredible donor support," says Jim Brown, Co-Chair along with Guy Scott of the Brain Centre Campaign. "We need the same support - and commitment from our government - to complete this final phase of the Brain Centre Campaign."

"We are very fortunate to have such an amazing facility right here in Edmonton. We're proud to be a part of it," says Harry Sunner, President of Durabuilt.



OUT OF OPTIONS

Jolissa Doerksen, 24, of Blumenort, Alberta (660 kilometres northwest of Edmonton) was still adjusting to life as a new mom when she became desperately ill.

Diagnosed with a deadly respiratory disease, by the time she arrived at the Maz she was out of options.

Doctors at the Maz immediately put Jolissa on Extracorporeal Life Support (ECLS). She spent the next two weeks in the Cardiovascular Intensive Care Unit before she could begin breathing on her own. Today, Jolissa is a happy, healthy mother of two beautiful girls.

Demand for ECLS has increased dramatically at the Maz, which had only two, 10 year-old ECLS machines. Thanks to donor support through 630 CHED Heart Pledge Day, doctors now have two more machines to save patients who have run out of options.

FULL SPEED AHEAD

MARSHALL ELIUK'S \$3 MILLION GIFT TO THE HEMATOLOGY UNIT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA HOSPITAL IS TRANSFORMING CARE FOR PATIENTS WITH BLOOD DISEASE.

Marshall Eliuk has lived much of his life in overdrive. At 14, he took a job as an auto mechanic. Fifteen years later, he bought his first car dealership in Peace River, Alberta.

Over the next 46 years, Marshall expanded his passion for business and entrepreneurship to include five car dealerships, and 286 residential and commercial properties throughout central and northern Alberta. "I've always had energy," he says. "I've always wanted to be doing something."

In 1999, doctors at the University of Alberta Hospital put the brakes on Marshall – temporarily. Diagnosed with a severe form of aplastic anemia, a rare and serious blood disease, he was put on a treatment program that called for the transfusion of six bags of platelets every three days for nine months.

Today, he's back up to full speed. "My doctors told me, 'Do this and hopefully things will work out." By the end of my treatment, my blood count had returned to normal. They called my recovery a miracle."

In gratitude for the life-saving care he received in the Hematology Unit at the University of Alberta Hospital, Marshall gave \$3 million to the University Hospital Foundation, establishing The Marshall Eliuk Fund for Clinical Innovation and Exemplary Care in Hematology.

"We've made many advancements in the treatment of both benign and malignant diseases related to blood cells," says Dr. Loree Larratt, Clinical Hematologist at the University of Alberta Hospital, and one of the doctors who cared for Marshall. "As the science progresses, we've developed new techniques that are essential in making the correct diagnosis."

The excitement that comes with new discoveries in hematology is curtailed by the cost in delivering them to the patients, adds Dr. Larratt. "That's why we are so grateful for Marshall's extraordinary gift to our program. It will make such a difference in what we're able to do."

DINING IN

THANKS TO THE MANY DONORS WHO SUPPORTED THE PROJECT, SENIORS IN THE ELDER FRIENDLY CARE UNIT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA HOSPITAL NOW HAVE THEIR OWN DINING ROOM TO SHARE MEALS, ENJOY TIME TOGETHER - AND BENEFIT FROM SOCIAL INTERACTION.

For many seniors, especially if they live alone, meal time is nothing to get excited about. What was once something to look forward to three times a day has become a chore they may not even bother with.

And when they get sick, being malnourished becomes a serious impediment to their recovery.

Thanks to donor support through the University Hospital Foundation, seniors in the Elder Friendly Care Unit at the University of Alberta Hospital have a new ally to help them get the nutrition they need to recover sooner – their own private dining room. The Dining Room, supported in large part by Orest Kotyshyn's generous bequest, opened in April 2017 (see Orest's story on page 49).

"Most of us grew up eating meals with other people," says Mina Pound, Patient Care Manager of the Elder Friendly Care Unit at the University of Alberta Hospital. "Meal times were for catching up, laughing, arguing, telling stories, and most importantly, being together."

"Giving seniors their own place to share meals and enjoy conversation is a significant step toward making them feel more 'at home' in an unfamiliar hospital setting," adds Dr. Wagg, Divisional Director of Geriatric Medicine.

"We know from research that seniors admitted to hospital are much more likely to be malnourished than any other patient group. That makes providing adequate nutrition while they're here extremely important, the first step of which is getting them to eat."

Malnourishment reduces the positive effect of rehabilitation, prolongs hospital stays, and can increase the risk of mortality by as much as four times.

"By turning dining into a social experience, patients will eat more, they'll start feeling better, and they'll return home sooner."

EXERCISE IS AS IMPORTANT AS NUTRITION

Walking to and from the dining room twice a day is just as important to the recovery process as eating and socializing, says Dr. Adrian Wagg, who also holds a research Chair in Healthy Aging. Between meals, the dining room will facilitate recreational therapy activities for older patients, further improving opportunities for socialization and exercise while they're in acute care.

Having a space to be social, to share meals, and to exercise will put patients' families at ease knowing that their loved ones are receiving great care – and that they are not alone.

BRINGING THE BEST

BY GIVING RECRUITS VITAL RESEARCH FUNDING TO HIT THE GROUND RUNNING, DONORS ARE HELPING TO ATTRACT THE BEST AND BRIGHTEST DOCTORS FROM AROUND THE WORLD TO THE UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA HOSPITAL, MAZANKOWSKI ALBERTA HEART INSTITUTE AND KAYE EDMONTON CLINIC.

After winning the most prestigious honour in the world for cardiac surgery residency training (the C Walton Lillehei, PhD MD Young Investigators Award), Dr. Jeevan Nagendran was a hot commodity. Not only that, his clinical area of expertise - minimally invasive cardiac surgery - made him a perfect fit for the Mazankowski Alberta Heart Institute. The challenge was how to get him here.

"Recruitment is a very competitive process," says Dr. Roderick MacArthur, Program Director, Division of Cardiac Surgery. "Without funding from the University Hospital Foundation, a lot of the doctors recruited [like Dr. Nagendran] would have gone somewhere else."

In Dr. Nagendran's case, three years of full research funding - courtesy of the donor supported Arvind Koshal Fund - along with working in one of the most advanced heart institutes in North America, was enough to attract him.

"Without the research funding, it's quite likely I would have gone somewhere else," says Dr. Nagendran. "In a heart surgeons career, we may perform 5,000 surgeries. That's helping a lot of people. But cardiac science research may lead to saving millions of people.

"Giving me what I need to hit the ground running as soon as I got here made all the difference. I am so grateful for the community support that made it possible."

INVESTMENTS IN RESEARCH CHANGE LIVES


From 2011 to 2016, the University Hospital Foundation distributed more than \$21 million in generous donations towards research at the University of Alberta Hospital, the Mazankowski Alberta Heart Institute and the Kaye Edmonton Clinic.

That support paved the way for advancements in organ transplantation by increasing the number of suitable donor organs; transformed stroke diagnosis and treatment at the University of Alberta Hospital; and provided invaluable seed funding for new, innovative research projects through the University Hospital Foundation's Medical Research Competition.

The ultimate goal of the fund is to advance long-term health outcomes, quality of life, and economic prosperity for Albertans.

It's also the perfect example of the University Hospital Foundation's Strategic Partnerships initiative which aims to increase the impact on patient care at the University of Alberta Hospital site through collaboration with partners from both the private and public sectors.

GREAT STEP FORWARD

"These new partnerships will build capacity for innovation that will change and save lives," says Bob Bessette, Chairman of the Board of Trustees for the University Hospital Foundation. "It's a great step forward for the University Hospital Foundation and all patients at the University of Alberta Hospital site."

Over the past year, the University Hospital Foundation also committed to a partnership with Alberta's Ministry of Economic Development and Trade and Servier Canada, resulting in the creation of a \$1.7 million Servier Alberta Innovation in Health Fund. The fund will focus on cardiac sciences, neurology, oncology, diabetes and real world evidence.

WHEN IT COMES TO BATTLING UROLOGIC DISEASE, THERE ARE NO BETTER PEOPLE TO CALL UPON THAN OUR DONORS

The C.J. Woods Prostate Health Clinic opened in the Kaye Edmonton Clinic's Northern Alberta Urology Centre - giving men with prostate cancer timely access to highly-trained specialists and the full range of advanced, patient-centred care.

Not only that, their care is coordinated by a dedicated Nurse Navigator who provides support, education, and much welcome guidance.


MULTIDISCIPLINARY CARE

"Our goal was to provide multidisciplinary, patient-focused care, and to have it all in one place," says Dr. Gerry Todd, Urologist and former Divisional Director of Urology at the University of Alberta Hospital. "We've accomplished that."

All thanks to generous community support, and the tireless leadership and commitment of the Campaign for Prostate Health, driven by University Hospital Foundation Trustees Emeritus Irv Kipnes and C.J. Woods, and John Day of the Royal Alexandra Hospital Foundation.

The crown jewel of the \$30 million Campaign for Prostate Health, the \$10 million C.J. Woods Prostate Health Clinic is "a dream come true" says Dr. Todd. "Prostate cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer among men. We now have the resources to provide the level of care they need to live productive, healthy lives."

The clinic is located in the new Northern Alberta Urology Clinic (NAUC), home to the most advanced prostate care for men, and the go-to care and treatment centre for men and women with other urologic conditions.







The Campaign for Prostate Health invested \$4 million in two state-of-the-art Da Vinci robotic surgery systems; hundreds of patients at the University of Alberta Hospital and the Royal Alexandra Hospital have benefitted from this minimally invasive surgical treatment.

When it comes to leading projects, C.J. Woods, FCA and Irv Kipnes, both Trustees Emeritus of the University Hospital Foundation, and Co-Chairs of the \$30 million Campaign for Prostate Health, are two of the best. A survivor of prostate cancer, Mr. Kipnes was awarded the Alberta Order of Excellence for his philanthropy.
Mr. Woods has received national recognition for his generosity and achievements as a community leader.

Together, they were the driving force behind the Campaign for Prostate Health that led to the formation of the Northern Alberta Urology Centre at the Kaye Edmonton Clinic.






GROWTH IN FUND BALANCES & ESTABLISHED FUNDS


YOUR GIFTS AT WORK

The University Hospital Foundation distributed \$14.2 million in 2016-2017 to support critical areas of patient care and medical research at the University of Alberta Hospital, the Mazankowski Alberta Heart Institute and the Kaye Edmonton Clinic.

Over the past 10 years, we have distributed more than \$93.6 million dollars to the University of Alberta Hospital site, and have made commitments to distribute another \$29.2 million over the next three years, bringing our total distributions from 2007-2020 to \$123 million.

INVEST IN IMPACT THROUGH DONOR CREATED ESTABLISHED FUNDS

In addition to tremendous community support, growth in our Established Funds has enhanced our ability to impact patient care. Over the past year, we added 7 new Established Funds, bringing our total to 211, with a total value of \$79 million.

Of the \$14.2 million that was distributed in 2016-2017, 28% (\$4.4 million), came from our Established Funds. Fund balances that are not distributed are invested within our balanced portfolio strategy.


The Foundation prides itself on being a secure place for donors to invest in long-term impact through the commitment that any unrealized market value losses are not allocated to the Established Funds. Instead, such losses are absorbed by the Foundation's General Fund.

THE ROLE OF INVESTMENTS

The growth of our investments allows the Foundation to provide sustained support to the University of Alberta Hospital site. During the 2016-2017 fiscal year, our investment returns remained strong, providing a total return of 9.54%.

Each year 80% of this investment income is allocated to our Established Funds. In 2016-2017, investment income was allocated to the Established Funds at a rate of 8.01% (\$5.7 million).

ENSURING FUNDRAISING EFFICIENCY

For the past five years, the Foundation achieved a cost to raise a dollar ratio (\$0.20 in 2016-2017), below the Association of Healthcare Philanthropy (AHP) benchmark (\$0.24 in 2016-2017).

The University Hospital Foundation complies with all regulatory requirements and uses Service Canada guidelines to calculate our cost of fundraising.



Terry Kotyshyn remembers the year his uncle Orest gave him an ant farm for his birthday. "He wasn't a socks and t-shirt guy when it came to gifts," says Terry. "He
